121. LOCAL HIGHWAYS MATTERS.

The Town Council received Mr Lyn Parry of Powys County Council in relation to developing a good working relationship with the Town Council on local highway matters. It was noted that the annual budget cuts in the service provided had resulted in an overall 53% financial cut. The Town Council discussed a number of local street highway concerns with the Powys County Council representatives. Following a lengthy discussion on the issues raised it was agreed that:

- a) In future the local area inspector was to deal directly with the four Ward Chairmen on all local service delivery matters and complaints. Contact details to be forwarded to the local inspector.
- b) The Town Council to be advised of the Road sweeper arrangements for the Ystradgynlais community area.
- c) The Powys County Council representatives examine the position regarding the litter bin sited on footpath 110 a and advise the Town Council as to whether some arrangement can be made regarding the emptying of this bin on a frequency to be agreed.
- d) Further information to be forwarded to the Town Council regarding the statutory provision relating to dog fouling in the area and what enforcement options were available e.g. powers of local police, environmental officers.
