60. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Mrs B Paulett, R Lock, N Craddock and M Evans.

61. DISCOVER YSTRADGYNLAIS/ BLODAU YSTRADGYNLAIS.

Both representatives gave a detailed account of their respective organisations in terms of their relationship, role in the community and constitutional position. Both organisations are totally dependant on the volunteer groups that support them. Discover Ystradgynlais took over from YSATT and has evolved the remit of the previous organisation. It has also applied for charitable status as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation. Any member of the community can join the Groups as volunteers. Council Members discussed the status of

both Groups and clarified many issues which had previously been unknown regarding their both organisations respective positions within the community. In essence both organisations sat under the same umbrella and had a very close relationship especially where local events are concerned but structurally wise they operated their own distinct Committees and had separate banking arrangements and accounts.

62. STAFFING REVIEW – DEPUTY CLERK.

Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960.

Resolved that by virtue of the provisions of Section 1(2) of the above Act, the public be excluded during the discussions of the business on the grounds that publicity would be prejudicial to the public interest by reasons of confidential nature of the business to be transacted.

Members received copies of the job applications received by the closing date of 26th July 2019, of which there were three in total. Members discussed in detail the options available and the content of the applications in line with the job requirements of the post in terms of the essential and desirable attributes identified. Also a proposed procedure for the interviews and questions for candidates at the interview were considered and agreed.

Following detailed consideration of the above matters, it was **resolved** that Ms JC and Ms CL be shortlisted for interview at the Town Councils meeting on Thursday 5th September 2019 commencing at 6.00pm.
