116. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

117. WELFARE HALL CHRISTMAS TREES POWER SUPPLY

An email from the Welfare Hall was read and discussed by the board regarding the requirement for external power to supply lighting for the Christmas Trees.

Resolved that a deactivated supply can be investigated with regard to the possibility of reconnecting and providing that the cost is reasonable budget then the works involved would be funded by the Town Council.

118. YSTRADGYNLAIS WELFARE HALL – Budget 2020/21

2) figures be obtained for the last three years funding towards Public Groups and to ascertain how the level of Reserve (contingency) can be raised, through either strategic budgeting or raising of precept.
